## Your System

To install and run all Lite-Specs applications, your system will need the following:

- One of the these operating systems: Microsoft Windows 95 Version B or higher, Windows 98, Windows ME, Microsoft Windows NT operating system with Service Pack 4 installed, Microsoft 2000 with Service Pack 1 installed, or Windows XP.
- Administrative privileges on the system if running Windows NT or Windows 2000.
- Microsoft Internet Explorer 4.01 (Service Pack 2) or higher if running Windows 95, Windows 98, or Windows NT.
- Super VGA monitor with a screen resolution set to at least 800 x 600, small fonts.
- 32 MB of RAM.

## Installation Notes

Running Lite-Specs requires that you have certain Microsoft system components installed on your system. The Lite-Specs setup will check your system for these components, and, if not present will automatically install them. So if you are running earlier versions of Windows, such as Windows 95, the setup will take longer.

If Windows prompts you to reboot your system, you will need to do so or Lite-Specs will not run properly.

If you want to modify, repair or remove your setup, select "Lite-Specs" from the Windows Control Panel Add/Remove Programs feature.
