## ***Installation***

### **Your System**

To install and run this program, your system will need the following:

- Administrative privileges on the system.
- Microsoft Internet Explorer 6 or higher.
- Super VGA monitor with a screen resolution set to at least 1024 x 758, small fonts.
- 32 MB of RAM.

### **Installation Notes:**

**Microsoft Vista, Windows 7, and Windows 8 Users** – If you are using Microsoft Vista, Windows 7 or 8 and you are having problems running the program you can try using the “Run as Administrator” option.

- 1) Locate the applications icon or short cut and Right click on it.
- 2) From the popup menu select properties and then select the Compatibility Tab.
- 3) Under Privilege Level, select Run this program as an administrator, and then click OK.

**Reboot** — If Windows prompts you to reboot your system, do so or Lite-Label may not run properly.

**Uninstalling the program** — Select Lite-Label from the Windows Control Panel Add/Remove Programs feature.
